

ADMISSION CRITERIA



Admission

Admission for all the classes from Std. L.K.G. to Std.-XII will be on gradation/mark basis as obtained from previous school records/ CBSE/ICSE/anyother equivalent board.

25% seats are reserved for SC/ST and BPL Students as per RTE Act.

Documents required at the time of Admission

The students must produce the following documents:

- 1. Xerox copy of Birth certificate.
- 2. Original School Leaving Certificate.
- 3. Original Conduct certificate.
- 4. Xerox copy of Migration (Other than CBSE Student)
- 5. Recent passport size photograph of Candidate.
- 6. Xerox copy of Aadhaar Card (Candidate, Father, Mother).
- 7. Photograph of Parents (Both Father & Mother), Guardian (if required)
- 8. Xerox copy of Certificate of Social Category, BPL Card, Physical Handicapped (if Any).
- 9. Student's PEN & APAAR ID.
- 10. Previous school UDISE Number.
- 11. Xerox copy Result sheet of Previous class.
- 12. Both the parents should be present along with the student at the time of admission.

N.B: Candidate's Name, Date of Birth, Father's Name, Mother's Name should be same in all the above documents.

Withdrawal

- 1. The principal reserves the right to ask for the withdrawal of any student who has proved immune to correction.
- 2. Request for the withdrawal of a pupil must be made in writing by his/her parent accompanied by a remittance of requisite fees for the issue of the school leaving certificate/Transfer Certificate.
- 3. All the dues have to be cleared before a school leaving certificate is issued. No question of refund of any dues of a child will arise at the time of withdrawal after getting admission into any class.



The student shall be suspended or expelled from the school on the following ground

- 1. Indiscipline, assaulting fellow students, mishandling of appliance fitted, carrying/bursting crackers, stealing, leaving the school without permission, Non payment of dues after three reminders.
- 2. On failing twice in the same class due to poor academic performance.
- 3. At any of time, if the authorities are satisfied that such withdrawal is necessary in the interest of the school.
- 4. Suspension can be done at any time, if the authorities are satisfied that such withdrawal is necessary in the interest of the school.
- 5. The name of the student will be struck off from the rolls after continuous absence for ten days without information. He/she may be readmitted as per rules by the discretion of the principal. Students are required to secure minimum 75% of the total attendance during a session to be eligible to appear in their final examination.
- 6. The decision of the principal shall be final and binding in this regard.

Withdrawal by Parents

- 1. If a student is withdrawn for any length of time and the parents wish him/her to be readmitted, admission fees will be charged again.
- 2. A written application must be made by the parents (Father or Mother) for the transfer certificate of the student.
- 3. The transfer certificate can be issued on payment of tuition fees of current month, only after all the fees and other dues of the school and hostel are cleared and verified after one week of applying.
- 4. Duplicate T.C. will be issued on production of an affidavit along with the T.C. fee of the current year.
- 5. For certificate of conduct or any other certificate and application forms should be submitted six days in advance for Principal's signature.
- 6. Generally withdrawals are not permitted except at the end of the session unless such withdrawal is warranted by transfer of the parent or guardian or similar circumstances.



Academics

Besides regular classes we provide extra remedial classes after school hour for the students having poor performance. The school also emphasizes on games and sports with other co-curricular activities to improve physical, emotional, social and moral aspects of the students.

Course Curriculum

Secondary Classes (L.K.G. to Std. X): English, Math, Science, S.S.T., EVS, Computer, Odia/Hindi, G.K., Art, Music with Smart Classes.

Senior Secondary Classes (Std. XI- to Std. XII): English, Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Biology, Physical Education.

Computer Education

The computer education in school is an essential part for the students. We have a well equipped computer laboratory having adequate number of computers with multimedia and internet facility.

Laboratories

The school has well equipped laboratories in different subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology and Computer science which are maintained by the trained Lab staff under the supervision of subject teacher.



Library

- The school has a well stocked library with well trained staff to keep the library in proper order and guide the students during their respective periods to make the maximum use of resources available.
- The School Library is well equipped with books on all subjects, journals, periodicals, competitive magazines for both the students and staff. The latest books on all subjects are procured and made available for use. A specially designed Reading Room which provides separate enclosure for each student to enable him/her to have brush with the great authors which is a unique feature of the school. The Library is open from 8 A.M. to 3.00 P.M. on every working day including vacations.
- Books will be issued through the student's diary only.
- A fine of Rs.1.00 per day will be charged if the book is not returned by the due date.
- In case loss or damage of the book, double cost of the book along with the fines accrued will be collected from the student.

Co-Curricular Adivities

Pupil's Diary

The school diary is intended to be used by the pupils to record their school activities and assignments. Parents/Guardians are required to keep in touch with their ward's day to day progress. This will establish a valuable liaison between the teachers and parents with regard to the quality of work being done by students both at school and home.

Students Safety Insurance

Students safety insurance policy has been introduced by the school, for which a sum of Rs. 5/- is payable by each student towards with the dues of April every year.

School Assembly

The school conducts an assembly daily before the beginning of classes. It is a congregation of the staff and the students where prayer and patriotic songs, relevant information is passed to all concerned. The daily News headlines, school news, the thought of the day are read out. Individual speakers among the students and the teachers deliberate on various informative and educative topics. This fosters a competitive spirit and gives wide exposure to the student.

Connect

Parent-Teacher Co-ordination Committee

Regular PTCC meeting are conducted to monitor the grogginess of the individual child and refurnish the entire teaching learning process. However, for the board appearing students PTCC meeting are called after every periodical and pre-board examination to solve the problem immediately. The individual ado is being taken care of by the mentors of respective subjects for the students to get through in the examination. PT meeting is held on every 2nd Saturday of every month.
